

Will of Dinah R. Cline.

I, Dinah R. Cline of the aforesaid County and State being of sound mind, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and Testament.

- First My Executor hereinafter named, shall give my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my friends and Relations and pay all funeral expenses together with all my just debts out of the first money which may come into his hands, belonging to my estate.
- Second I give and bequeath to six of my children namely John A. Cline, J. B. Cline, J. S. Cline, Mrs. S. C. Miller, C. C. Cline Mrs. S. H. League a parcel of land, lying on a new street and beginning on Eldred Hupmans South East corner on west side of said new street and running South with said street to Wm. Hawk's line on a cross street and is to be divided into six equal lots containing $\frac{3}{4}$ acres each fronting on said street.
- Third I give and bequeath to my beloved husband Max A. Cline Two lots containing one acre each front on South Fork street on east side of said street joining on the south John F. Probst.
- Fourth I give and bequeath to my beloved husband Max A. Cline and my daughter Barbara Jane Smith all the remainder of my lands known as the Moss Berger lands to be equally divided between them.
- Sixth I give and bequeath to my beloved husband Max A. Cline one lot on South Fork Street joining the oil house lot. The lot to be sold to satisfy certain claims of Ottobex and after said claims is satisfied the remainder to belong to the said Max A. Cline.
- Seventh I give and bequeath to my beloved husband Max A. Cline all my personal property including household and kitchen furniture.
- Eighth My will and desire is that all the residue of my estate of any after taking out the Devises and Legacies that such surplus shall be equally divided among all my children.
- Ninth I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved husband Max A. Cline my lawfull executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other wills and Testaments by me heretofore made
