In the name of God the Father, & Elizabeth Clay of the County of Catawba and State of North Carolina old, of sound mind & memory and Considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life do therefore make, revise, publish & declare this to be my last will and testament that is to say

My dear Brother David Clay which where I now live keeps sufficient maintenance during my natural life to bequeath unto him all my property which I now have in his house to wit one Overcoat & one Bonnet & one Chest &c. Two hand towels with all their Clothing and Bed & one wheel one wash pot one Coate & Pot Two waist coats one pair - Watch \$150.00 the rest of clothing not named. Also three notes of hand payable to me one in H. Wilson for Two hundred & forty six dollars Principal, dated June 13rd 1859 and one to John Stoops for Jonathan Collins dated April 11th 1859 and one to Noah Sizman for Five dollars dated May 18th 1859 with full power to collect the same for his uses due after he shall have paid all my Doctor Bills that may be against me at my Death (if my Health) whenever I set my hand & seal this the 16th day of August 1865

I Barret Klein of the County & state aforesaid being of perfect mind and memory but knowing the uncertainty of life and having in a few days to leave to join the Confederate army. I therefore make publish and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner & form following.

First My Will and desire is that my beloved wife Anna Klein after my death shall have all of my property both Real and Personal to have and to hold the same as if I was living but since she marry again then & in that case said property shall at once go to my two children but in case she shall remain a widow she shall have and hold said property during her natural life and at her death to my two children J. Hart & Amanda E. Klein to be equally divided. I further will that my said wife pay my just debts if any so testimony whereof I have set my hand and sealed this 30th day of Sept'r 1863
