which they are to have when they come at the age of eighteen
or at the death of my beloved wife.

I give and bequeath to my son George Wilson Powell
one half of the land which my father has now in possession.
My will and desire is that all the debts of my estate if any
after taken out the taxes and legacies above mentioned shall
be paid and the debts owing to me collected if there should be
any and balance over and above the payment of any debts expenses
and charges that such surplus shall be equally divided and paid
over to my daughter Anna & Powell wife of Smith & Powell
and my four grand children when they come of age Anna
Elizabeth Mary Louisa Catharine George Wilson the children of
Smith & Powell & George & Powell wife of Smith & Powell.

And I hereby do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friend
Arthur Wilson being my lawful executor to all intents and
purposes to execute this my last will and testament according to
the true intent and meaning of the same and any part and
clause thereof and waiving and disclaiming setting aside all
other wills and testaments by me heretofore made.

all my furniture & kitchen furniture and all my books
and I hereby make and declare my Nephew Austin Carmichael
Executor of this my last will and testament in writing whereof
I the said Elizabeth Dillon have to this my last will and
testament, let my hand and seal the day and year above written
Signed sealed and declared by Elizabeth Dillon the testator at
