

October Session 1864

- 174 In the name of God, I, Mrs. Barbara Sigmone of the County of Catawba & State of North Carolina being in reasonable health & in perfect mind and memory and knowing that it is expedient for all persons about to die to make this my last will & testament in the following manner & form viz  
 1<sup>o</sup> I give and bequeath my soul to Almighty God who gave it hoping to have a general Resurrection at the last day and my body I desire to be buried in a decent Christian manner  
 2<sup>o</sup> I will & bequeath unto my son, Abel Sigmone an negro boy named Wilson and also my son Jacob Sigmone to give Abel Sigmone Two hundred Dollars and also two head of Horses one named Bill & Kate and also one hotted and also the hogs he has got hotted & also one large Chest  
 3<sup>o</sup> I will & bequeath unto my son Jacob Sigmone all the Plantation I now live on and also four head of horses colph fair gray & Calm red & black & also one Clock and also all the hoggs and also the windmill I will to my two sons Abel & Jacob Sigmone jointly and also one wagon jointly and it is my will that my son Jacob Sigmone is to maintain me decently my life time  
 4<sup>o</sup> I will and bequeath unto my daughter Sally widow one room and the balance of my house later furniture after my death  
 See witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and signed my seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 1864.

January Session 1865

- 175 In the name of God Amen, I Eliza Scott being of sound mind and memory but Considering the uncertainty of life do make publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows to wit  
 1<sup>o</sup> I will & bequeath unto my son C P Scott all my real estate including the plantation Abbeau & not live to him & his heirs forever with all the appurtenances thereto belonging.  
 2<sup>o</sup> I will will leave unto my children the slaves Brown, Caroline, Amos and Henry Marshall and Mattie Scott all my negroes & other personal estate by let my negro woman Elizabeth to the family divided between them after the first payment to all my just debts  
 3<sup>o</sup> I will my daughter Mattie Scott to have my negro woman Elizabeth in addition to her portion in my personal estate  
 And Lastly I hereby appoint my beloved Brother R P Reinhardt the executor of this my last will & testament  
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 1865
