Ephraim Herman deceased.

I Ephraim A. Herman, being afflicted in body for many months and being of sound mind, do herein make my last Will and Testament before I go hence and am seen here no more.

- I will and bequeath to my beloved wife, Mary Anna, all my possessions, my property, personal and real — embracing all my lands, notes, moneys accounts, due me, all household and kitchen furniture, all my stock, farming tools every thing I possess, to be hers, under her control and at her disposal so long as she lives or remains my widow.
- I will and direct that my beloved wife, Mary Anna pay all my just debts, and give my body a decent burial.
- Should my beloved wife, Mary Anna marry, it is then my will and I direct, that all my property, real and personal be no longer under her control and at her disposal; and in that event I will and direct that the court appoint for my estate a suitable Administrator, to divide and parcel out all my possession, real and personal, equally among all my children; and moreover in that event, I will and direct that my wife receive out of my estate the sum of Two hundred dollars in money, leaving all the rest to be equally divided among all my children.
- I will and direct, that <sup>in the event</sup> my wife, Mary Anna, all my property and possessions whatever, real and personal be equally divided among all my children.
- It is my will, and I direct, that my beloved wife, should it be her desire, that she make a sale of such property and plunder as would be of no real service or benefit to her.
