I, G. A. Barringer of the County of Catawba and State of North Carolina,
Being of sound mind and memory but anxiousing the opportunity of my
deathly existence, do make & declare this my last Will & Testament in
manner and form following, that is to say,

First That my Executor (benin other named) shall provide for my body
a decent burial, suitable to the wishes of my relatives & friends, & pay
all funeral expenses, together with my just debts, however & to
whomsoever laying out of the money which may first come into his
hands as a result or product of my estate.

Second I give & devise to my beloved wife, all my property, land
& property & every thing of every description which she, to have and
to hold to her the same as her own during her natural life --
provided she does not marry again, but if she should she may, again
then next in that case I desire my Executor to sell all my property
and the money occurring therefrom & the money on hand to be at
interest to be distributed equally among my children, and I further
my wife die before my children become of age than at her death I
desire my property best & all my money equally divided among
my children.

Third should my wife die before my children become of
age then I desire by will that my Executor be & is hereby consti-
tuted & appointed guardian for all my children & to hold in
guardianship all of their respective estates until they shall
arrive at the full age of twenty one years.

Fourth I do hereby constitute & appoint my trusty friends
W. B. Estes & C. P. Smith my faithful executors to last intitute
& possess to execute this my last Will & Testament, according to the
true intent & meaning of the same, & every part & clause thereof --
hereby revoking all & canceling whatever I have all other Wills and
Testaments by me heretofore made.

In witness whereof, of the date 27th June do hereunto set my hand
& seal this the twenty ninth day of July A.D. 1862

I, G. A. Barringer of the County of Catawba and State aforesaid
being in Perfect mind and memory but having to enter the service
of my Country and knowing the uncertainty of life do make
Publick and declare this my last Will & Testament in manner &
form following

First My will and desire is that my just debts shall be paid out of
my present growing Crop & further I will & bequeath that the
children which Sarah S. Knott has or may have in the next two
months two being born and named Abby A. and John B. and one
not born which I claim as my children and shall have all of
my estate real & personal to be put into a guardians hands and
she to rent or have my lands and negroes and the proceeds to go to
said children But my will is that my property shall not be sold
at any rate my lands nor negroes (unless they cannot be managed)
until the said two children and one expectec shall become of age
My further will is that every thing remain as it is, I have reference
to my farms and negroes & for the guardian of my said children
to manage as if I was living. I further will and it is my desire
that Sarah S. Knott live in my dwelling house and there to remain
until the said children become of age unless she shall marry
or have any more children after the said two months time and
in that case said guardian is to remove the said Sarah S. Knott
My further will is that said children be well educated out of the
proceeds of my farms

My further will and desire is that my Brother Noah Barringer
be guardian of the said children at in case of his death same
as of my brother or my father.
