

Last Will & Testament of H. H. Linbarger, decd.

In the name of God, Amen. I H. H. Linbarger of County of Catawba and State of North Carolina being in health of body and of sound mind and memory and understanding (I have believed for the same) do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following. I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter in law Mary H. Linbarger, two whole beds including the Steads and all belonging thereto. One falling Bed table, One set of cane bottom chairs, one Centre table with oil cloth over for the same, one large candle stand, One looking glass setting on the mantle piece, One clothes Dress and its contents with the understanding that she (Mary H. Linbarger) is to pay my son Worth Linbarger eight dollars for the same, One set of tea spoons (silver), One dinner bell, One set of fire dogs, One sausage grinder, One large cupboard with the understanding that if her son Jacob ever needs one she is to give him here or get him another, One large chest, One small draw scales, All contents of smoke house, All contents of cellar, All framed pictures in the house. Two trunks, one large & one small one, One white stone pitcher, All wares that are in the cupboard, All earthen ware, One large tin can with contents of vinegar, One Corn Sheller, One Crook Reel, Two smoothing irons.

I do give devise and bequeath unto my grandson, Jacob A. Linbarger, Two whole beds and Steads and all that belong thereto. All the split bottomed chairs, One large Clock, One Cook Stone with all vessels belonging to it, All farming implements, One large wash pot, and one small pot, and one small skillet, One small candle stand with cover and one wash stand, One small walnut table and one oil table cloth, one looking glass, One milk Churn, One Grind Stone.

I do give devise and bequeath to my son Augustus Linbarger, one hundred Dollars in notes and accounts by him due me.

I do nominate constitute and appoint Mary H. Linbarger sole executor of this my last will and testament, hereby making void

all and every other will & wills at any time
heretofore made by me and I do declare this to be
my last will & testament.

It is my request that this will be read at the grave
yard at my burial.
