

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF E.O. ELLIOTT.

In the name of God, Amen! I the undersigned E.O. Elliott do hereby make this my last will and testament.

ITEM 1. I give and bequeath to my daughter Emma Elliott my bank stock in the Commercial National Bank of Charlotte, N.C. consisting of ten shares of the par value of one hundred dollars each.

ITEM 2. I give and bequeath to my son Frank O. Elliott Five hundred dollars in cash to be paid out of my estate, real and personal.

Item 3. All the rest of my estate of every kind both real and personal, the realty consisting of a number of tracts, parcels and lots of land in this county of Catawba and in other counties-(excepting the lots owned by me in the city of Charlotte, N.C.) and the personalty consisting of horses, cows, and other animals, farming implements, household and kitchen furniture here and in Statesville, and other articles too tedious to mention, as well as evidences of debt and choses in action-after all my just debts have been paid out of the same,-I devise and bequeath equally, share and share alike, to my beloved wife Martha J. Elliott and my three children Mrs. Fredonia Anderson, Frank O. Elliott and Emma Elliott; and the a forementioned lots in Charlotte I devise to my said wife Martha J. Elliott alone.

ITEM 4. I hereby appoint my wife Martha J. Elliott, my son-in-law W.E. Anderson, and my son Frank O. Elliott the executors of this my will and testament.
