Niram Sherill of the County of Calvert and State of North Carolina being in feeble health & of sound mind and memory doth this 25 day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine, do make and publish this my last will and testament in writing and seal it with my hand and affix my signature thereto. That is to say I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Sherill the use of all my lands and negroes during her lifetime with the exception of one negro boy named Frank the Negro Woman named Sophia to dispose of as she may see proper and also the house hold and kitchen furniture with the exception of three beds and one Bureau for her to dispose of as she may see proper by Haggards and Cleaning Scouring Tools Buggy and harness for her life time I also give and bequeath to my wife Sarah one Park Hog & two Hinds of my next hogs half of my cattle & Sheep I also give my wife one hundred pounds of sugar and fifty pounds of coffee also give my wife Sarah one head of Horses known by the name of Creek and also Mitts here directs that if the negroes that I have left to my wife should become unmanageable that my wife cannot manage them for my executors to hire them out and pay the proceeds of the hire to my wife I also will and bequeath to my wife Sarah all of my corn and wheat now or hereafter shall sell three hundred bushels of corn and seventy five bushels of that I also give and bequeath to my wife Twenty five dollars to buy harness that I have not given her and all of my bed stands.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Samuela Jones the sum of two hundred dollars for her Maintenance in her old age and if not used for the above named purpose to be disposed of as she may see proper I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Martha Pitten the sum of One hundred dollars and one Bureau that I bought at Pitten's Store I give and bequeath to my grand son Thomas B Pitten the sum of three hundred dollars I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Cecilia J Jones the sum of one hundred dollars as soon as she shall become twenty one years of age and if she should die before that age for the same to go to her half brother and sister.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Margaret Robinson one negro girl by the name of Bells and child named Anna,

I will and bequeath to my Grand son Niram P Robinson the sum of one hundred dollars and also my Grand son Thomas B Pitten the sum of one hundred dollars

I give and bequeath to my daughter Sethena Pitten the sum of One thousand dollars to be laid out for a tract or parcel of land by my executors who shall hold the same in trust for a home for the sole and separate use of the family free from any entitle by or on account of the present or any future husband subject to the directions of my executors and at the death of my daughter Sethena Pitten and husband

I will and direct that the lands be sold and equally divided among my daughter Barbara Pitten children by my executors in their succession first and third that my executors pay to Mary Clark Pitten my grand daughter the sum of Five hundred dollars as soon as she shall become Sixty one years of age I give and bequeath to my grand daughter Emeline Pitten Pitten the like sum of Five hundred dollars as soon as she shall become Sixty one years of age and if either of my grand daughters Mary Clark Pitten or Emeline Pitten shall die before they come to the age of Sixty one years the surviving sister shall have her share and if they should both die before the age of Sixty one years then the sum to be divided shall be paid to my executors to be divided equally I will and bequeath to my son Isaac A Sherill one negro boy by the name of William and also all of my Rail Road Stock I give and bequeath to my son William A Sherill one thousand dollars one cow and half one sow and Pigs one plow and gear and one bed and furniture I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Jane Burns one negro girl by the name of Hannah also one other negro girl by the name of Anna and her child and one yellow Bureau and as soon as my daughter Mary Jane Burns shall come into possession of her last negro she shall pay back to my executors the sum of Seven hundred dollars.

I give and bequeath to my son Moses N Sherill one tract of Land known as the Auburn Robinson tract I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Elizabeth Bartlett one negro girl by the name of Adeline and two hundred dollars I give and bequeath to my son Willis A Sherill one tract of Land lying in the Patuxent River adjoining the lands of Elisha Sherill and the lands of the heirs of Ruthie Sherill and also one hundred and Thirty acres that I bought from David Scher John Sherill and Scotland Sherill and one negro boy by the name of Elijah and one young horse known by the name of Jack and bed and furniture one Cow and half one sow and gears one sow and pigs and when he shall come into possession of the above named property he shall pay to my executors the sum of Seven hundred dollars I give and bequeath to my son James Albert Sherill my home tract of land and also the Sean Sherill tract lying on the Patuxent River one negro boy the name of whom is going to have by the name of Chester one Cow and half one bed and furniture one sow Pigs Pigs Pigs and Crows one saddle and bridle and when he shall come into possession of the above named property he shall pay to my executors the sum of forty dollars I hereby constitute and appoint my son Moses A Sherill my son in law Marion Pitten his executors of this my last will and testament fully revoking all other and former wills by me at any time herefore made In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this day and year first above written signed sealed & published by the above named Niram Sherill as and for his last will and testament in the presence of us who on his Request were present and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as witness
