In the name of God I Isaac Lowrance of Catawba County and State of North Carolina being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed by god do this twenty fourth day of June one thousand eight hundred and forty three make & publish this my last will & testament in manner following to wit first I give & bequeath my soul to god who gave it & my body to be decently buried and that all of my just debts be paid out of my effects
 2^d I give & bequeath unto my son Alexander Lowrance two hundred and four acres of Land in Iredell County wheron he lives for which I have heretofore maid him a deed I also value the same to him at Eight hundred & twenty dollars I also will him two head of cattle one Keverow one Head & furniture all of which he has received I value the same to him at sixty three dollars six hundred dollars of which he is to have as his proportionable part of my Estate the balance of the above amount which is two hundred & Eighty three dollars he is to pay over to my Executrix to be disposed of as hereinafter directed —
 3^d I give & bequeath unto my son Lawson Lowrance one hundred & ten acres of Land on the waters of Little Creek in said County for which I have made him a deed heretofore I also value the land to him at six hundred & sixty dollars also one horse bract valued at twenty five dollars one Cow & half valued twelve dollars one Keverow valued at twenty dollars Head at twenty five dollars all of which he has received six hundred dollars of which I will to my son Lawson to be his proportionable parts of my Estate the balance of the above amount received by him to be paid over to my Executrix to be disposed of as hereinafter directed —
 4^d I will unto my son John Lowrance one hundred & fifty acres of Land in Iredell County wheron he lives now valued to him at four hundred & fifty dollars for which I have not maid him a deed yet one horse valued at forty dollars one Cow & half valued at twelve dollars one Keverow valued at twenty dollars one Head valued at twenty five dollars all of which he has received amounting to five hundred & forty seven dollars I also will that John have six hundred dollars with which he has received from me to be given him by my Executrix out of the over plus account by those of my children who has received more than six hundred dollars their proportionable parts.
 5^d I will unto my son Eli G Lowrance one hundred & eighty Acres of Land in the County of Iredell wheron he lives valued at five hundred & forty dollars also one cow valued at eleven dollars one Keverow valued at twenty one head valued at twenty five dollars and of which he has received I will he have six hundred dollars including what he has received of me to be given him by my Executrix out of the overplus of my Estate received by those that have received more than six hundred dollars

6th I will & bequeath unto Logan A Lourance one cow & calf valued at twelve dollars one bed & furniture valued at twenty five dollars which he has received also my negro man Pesar & also one fifty dollar note that I hold on him to be his part of my estate & that I intend that I intend for him —

7th I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Julia one cow and calf one bed one young mare all of which she has received also my negro girl Lucy to be her share of my estate —

8th I will & bequeath unto Joseph Lourance forty seven acres of land on balls creek & the mills on the same valued to him at six hundred dollars for which I have heretofore made him a due also one cow & Calf valued at ten dollars one bed & furniture at twenty five dollars all of which he has received six hundred dollars of which is to be his portion all parts of my estate the balance of what he has received to be paid my executors to be disposed of as herein directed —

9th I give and bequeath unto my son Jacob Lourance one cow & Calf valued at twelve dollars one bed & furniture valued at twenty five dollars which he has received I also will that Jacob get five hundred & sixty three dollars more of my estate which is to be his proportionate parts —

10th I will & bequeath unto my son Martin Anna Lourance a part of my plantation whereon I first begining at a pine the North East corner of the old tract on Ben Sherrills line west with my old line fifty two rods to a sassafras tree then a south course to the negro garden yard then east to the first bend of the creek thence up the various bounes of the creek to the old line all the land & ascertain as their are belonging on the East side of said line & on the South of the creek also I allow the said land to cane at Nine hundred dollars also one cow valued at Eleven dollars also one Bed six hundred dollars of bed bequest to be his parts of my estate

11th I will that he pay my executors three hundred dollars to be his part of as herein directed 12th I will & bequeath unto my son Eli Lourance my negro boy Cyrus in special trust for the benefit of my son Sidney A Lourance as I shall here after direct

13th I will that at my death my son Eli Lourance take into possession the boy Silas & to hire him out & the proceeds of his hire to be applied to the use and support of my son Sidney A Lourance & his family as may seem best to my son Eli Lourance for the comfort of my son Sidney A Lourance & his family 2^d it is further my will that if my son Nelson should die before his wife in that event I instruct my son Eli to apply the proceeds of the hire Silas to the use of Nelsons widow and his children as he may deem best & at the death or marriage of his widow I instruct my son to sell Silas and the money to be equally divided between my sons Nelsons Children share and share alike after my son Eli Lourance retain in his hand a reasonable

compensation for his trouble 12th I will & bequeath unto my daughter Catharine Makala one cow one head & one three year old horse Cattle all of which has received I further will that Makala have my negro boy Bob as her portion of my Estate 13th I will & bequeath unto my son Morris Lourain three milk Cows the oxen & old wagon & the bay mare one head and furniture also I bequeath to him the Balance of the plantation with the improvement whereon I have not heretofore disposed of I also give to him my negro boy Umphrey as his part of my Estate I further will that Clinton take care of my old slave phebe & treat her humbly during her lifetime 14th I further will & direct my Executors to sell my two negro boys Ben & Harry & also Stock & Crops my other property not otherwise disposed of and to apply the proceeds of said sale & also the overplus heretofore accrued by some of my children which has accrued more than six hundred dollars to the use of paying my debts to make up the amount the amount of six hundred dollars to those of my children that has not accrued that amount as herein before directed and I do hereby constitute & appoint my two sons Eli & Lourain & Joseph M Lourain my Executors of this my last will & Testament declaring all for me wold in witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day & date above

In the name of God amen I Catharine Angel of the County of Lincoln in a State of North Carolina being in common good health and in perfect mind and memory knowing that it is appointed for all persons to die do this 11th of November AD 1843 make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form as follows Viz 1st I give and bequeath to my son John Angel two negroes namely Peter and James to him and his heirs for ever — 2^d I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy A negro boy named Simon during his natural life time and at the death of my daughter Nancy the said negro Simon to go to her heirs — 3rd I give and bequeath to my son John and my daughter Nancy each one head and its furniture to be of the description that I have in my house at this time
