I, L S Killian being of sound memory and mind, do make this my last Will and Testament that is to say:-

1 I will and devise to my niece Susie Lutz, wife of Alanzo Lutz, that tract of land lying in Catawba County, known as the Berry tract, containing fifty acres, adjoining the lands of Noah Lutz, Cyrus Frazier and Melchi Rhodes, being the land conveyed to me by L M Berry and wife by deed dated July 15th 1872; the said land to be the sole and separate property of the said Susie Lutz, free from any and all use or control of her said husband, and the said Susie Lutz is hereby authorized and empowered to use the rents and profits thereof and receive and enjoy the same and to sell and convey the lands by deed or will free from any interference or control or authority from her said husband.

2 I will and devise to my nephew R B Killian, upon the considerations herein after named:- (1) my home tract of land on which is my residence lying partly in Catawba and partly in Lincoln County, containing 80 acres, adjoining the lands of Melchi Rhodes, Wm Ramsauer, A B Hooker's estate and the John Smyre tract now owned by Genelia Frazier; (2) also that tract in Lincoln County known as the Absalom Brown tract containing 140 acres lying near Salem Church in said County, adjoining the lands of Henry M Hedin, Melchi Rhodes, John Killian's wife, Emma and Jessie Killian being the land conveyed to me by F L Brown and wife, by deed dated August 19th 1887, registered in Lincoln County Book 60, pages 119 and 120

3 The above mentioned tract, the home tract and the Absalom Brown tract, are devised to my nephew R B Killian upon the express conditions and agreement that the
