memory and of sound and disposing mind do make this my last
will and testament first of all I will that all my just debts and
funeral expenses be paid 2^d I will and bequeath to sons Ephraim
& Noah all my Land 3^d I will that Ephraim & Noah do let my
dear beloved wife have her support on the land and and they
have all the privilege of the land except what will support
her comfortable 4th I will and bequeath to my son Ephraim one
horse his choice of all my horses and two cows his choice of all my
stock of cattle 5th I will that all the rest of my property be sold
and Equally divided among my Children Except Ephraim
& Noah how shall have any thing except what is contained in
this will & I son my son shall account in his settlement fifty
dollars which I have charged to him as a part of his legacy
and my son Jacob shall account in his settlement forty
dollars which I have charged to him as a part of his legacy
and my son Absalom shall account for ten dollars in his settlement
which I have charged to him as a part of his legacy
6th I will and bequeath to my daughter Susannah one good
Bed and furniture one wheel and cards besides her equal
part with all the rest of my Children and shall have a home
on my land as long as she is single except in the land
7th I will and bequeath to all my Children that live at
with me all the grand that is on hand to be used in the family
8th I will that my wife have her saddle and at her death it be
given to my daughter Susannah I Jacob Sipe do confess and
acknowledge this to be my last will and testament in presents of
the subscribing witness on the 2 day of April 1843
and I appoint John Sipe & Noah Sipe my sons to be my Executors
in the will
