In the name of God Amen.

I, Jesse Gant Sen, of the County of Catawba & State of
North Carolina, being of sound mind and memory but
considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence
and certainty of death do make and declare the
following to be my last will and testament in manner
and form following.

That my executors hereafter named shall provide for
my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of
my relations friends, and pay all my just
debts out of the first money that may come
into his hands as a part or parcel of
my estate.

Give and devise unto my son Jesse Gant Jr
all the upper part of my tract or tracts of land bounded
as follows - Beginning at the Creek bank at
a post oak (Liles Creek road runs S. 10° West 30 poles
to a Spanish oak, thence S. 38° East 39 poles to a post
oak near an old field, thence South 34° West 32 poles
leaving the J. S. James Spring on the East side to a
saur tree, thence N.W. East 48 poles to a sourwood, thence
South 25° West 18 poles to a post oak, thence South
45° East 36 poles to a black oak, thence South 30° West 18
poles to a stake on the Lee land now owned by
the said Jesse Gant Jr, thence with Jerrys line
to either Tongue or the various Curves to Paul
Kemmerer, line then with Paul Kemmerer's line
& then to the Lee line down the creek
to the beginning, the J. S. James, must pay to my executors
for my estate / the sum of One hundred fifty dollars
\$150.00.

I will and devise to my son Ean Gant, all the lower
part of tract or tracts of land bounded as follows:
Beginning on the bank of Liles Creek at a post oak

I will and devise unto my daughter Eliza Gant two beds and Steds, One Cow & calf her choice one sow &猪 her choice, 1 Beacon (the Gimy Lucy) & clear all the debt, Kitchen & other Tumblers, also the Cupboard on table, fifty bushels corn, Two hundred lbs of pork or bacon & all the Cooking utensils, sand wash pot, 6 Sitting Chairs, one Sopha & Cradle, one Barn and One Clock & the long Clock, the Room place I have deeded in Trust for her use to pass Eliza.

My son Marion Gant is fully inherited as I have made arrangements to him before and put in Trust to Jones Cline for his use & family said deed bearing date 14th January 1868.

I give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Deborah Upmt, Ex. Hoke, Sina J. Cline & Carolines Children 4 bed & Steds or all the balance of my bed & Steds to be equally divided amongst them,

I will and devise that my Executor sell all the remainder of my property both real & personal and that after my just debts are paid off & all the balance of my estate be equally divided and distributed to and amongst my daughters viz: Deborah Upmt, Ex. Hoke, Sina J. Cline and Carolines Clines dec. Children

I do hereby constitute & appoint my trusty friend & min law York Cline my lawful Executor to all intents & purposes to execute this my last Will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other Wills & Testaments by me made heretofore.
