 First of all I give unto my beloved wife Caroline my lands horses cattle & every thing belonging to me till after her death then it is to be divided between my five children I appoint A. J. Whittle my wife's sole executor in writing whereunto we set our hands & seals this the 21st of October in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty two

Wilson get one sixth part Sophia & Beale one sixth part to be left in the hands of Gilbert A. Milligan for her use and at her death to go to her three Daughters Rebecca, Sarah Catharine, Maria Elizabeth, Grand Daughter of Rebecca Milligan I will that Gilbert A. Milligan get one sixth part my Grand Daughter Rebecca Anna Robinson one sixth part and if she should die without an heir I shall go back to the rest of the heirs I will that my Corp Stock for raising tools house hold Kitchen furniture be sold or divided excepting falling leaf Table I will to Gilbert A. Milligan my debts to be paid & my funeral expenses to be paid & the balance to be divided to the above named heirs but Sophia Beale to go in the hands of Gilbert A.
