121 I John Edwards of the County of Catawba and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that it is to say first that my Executor hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the worth of my body and pay all funeral expenses, together with my just debts, encumbrances and memorandum owing out of the moneys that may best come into their hands as a part or parcel of my estate, 1st I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy During her lifetime after the first partition of my land one hundred and five acres of land including all the improvements on the same also forty five acres of land lying the above named lands on the west side of Shady Woodland also my Negro woman Anna Cee and Negro boy Peter one White Cow, one gray Horse, one carriage and gear, six Head of sheep, six Chickens, one saw and two axes and five larger logs, two chairs, my large Bible, two beds and furniture all the Kitchen furniture, Bullock Chaise Two Pots Kettle & one Chest, two Chairs One Wheel & Cards one Loom gear & Rugs, also iron & Whist sufficient to see me & my family during winter, also sugar and coffee salt, sugar & Spice & ginger, two ploughs, two hoes, hay fork, Mattock, two Axes, one Hatchet, wash tub, two water pails, Milk Buckets, one Iron tooth Harrow, fifty pounds of Fresh Cotton, also a reasonable portion of sweet & fish potatoes, and I will and devise to my children as follows, 2nd I will to my daughter Sally Edwards, and her husband this one Negro girl named Jane, 3rd I will to my son Herbert Edwards one Negro boy named Tom, 4th I will to my son Lewis Edwards one Negro boy named George, 5th I will to my son Miles Edwards one Negro boy named Bradford 6th I will to my son Jacob Edwards one Negro girl named Mandy 7th I will to my daughter Emily Edwards one Negro girl named Cecilia 8th I will to my son Jerry Edwards one Negro boy named Thomas I also will to my two sons Lewis Edwards & Jerry Edwards at the decease of my wife Nancy the two Negroes will take During her life Lewis to get all increase & her Increase if any from this date and to have the Negro boy named Robert & his two Negroes Cecilia

& Elbert to be valued by three disinterested persons, and the valuation to be equally divided between my three sons that is to say Harriet, Jacob, Lewis Miles and Jerry Edwards. 9th I will to my son John Edwards Deceased his body to his widow Mrs. Jane Edwards Two hundred Dollars, 10th I will to my son Ephraim Edwards Two hundred Dollars, 11th I will to my son Elsie Edwards Deceased to his widow Mrs. Jane Edwards One hundred Dollars also one hundred Dollars which I agreed to pay for expenses in carrying the widow & children to N. Carolina, the last named hundred dollars to go to the heirs and to take the above named 100 hundred Dollars, I will my Executors to sell the following described Land at publick sale & all the land lying on the East side of the old Turn Road joining Wilson Jones road each of my sons I have given a horse (except therefore) also will to each of my sons Jacob, Lewis Miles, and Jerry, one bed and furniture also to my Daughter coming one Bed & furniture & Bald roof to my sons Herbert Edwards & Fred Edwards Lewis Edwards Ephraim Edwards & Jerry Edwards, and they also My Daughter Emily Edwards, all my Lands I own to not otherwise disposed of to be equally divided among my last named six sons and my Daughter Emily, and after the death of my wife Nancy the land I leave for her to be equally divided among the seven heirs as the other Lands shall & share alike and the property not disposed of I wish sold at publick sale, and the proceeds to pay my debts and what so ever else it is my wish and desire that my Executors see to my wife's business, Willing getting wood laying in and especially take care of their mother and lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my two sons, Lee Edwards, Jerry Edwards, my lawful Executors to all intents and purposes, to execute this my last will and Testament according to the true intent & meaning of the same & my part thereof, Revoking & Repealing all other wills and in witness whereof I the said John Edwards do hereby set my hand & seal this 25th Day of June 1860 signed sealed published & Declared by the said John Edwards to be his last will & Testament in presence of us by his request do subscribe our names as witnesses thereto, John Edwards
