

# October Session 1863

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In the name of God, Amen. I Rebecca Hoche widow, of the County of Catawba and State of North Carolina being in moderate good health and of disposing mind & memory have taken into consideration this life being so uncertain do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner & form as follows to wit my body I Command to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my executors hereof be named and as for that worldly estate which God has blessed me with I dispose of in the following manner

- 1) I give and bequeath to my adopted daughter that I now have living with me by the name of Sarah Ann Catherine Grant daughter of Aminda Brown (that is) widow, all my estate of every description except my wearing apparel such as my clothing I leave to Aminda Brown the woman that I named, and lastly I constitute and appoint Levi Brown and Matthew Mcintosh as my lawful executors to this my last will & Testament Revoking all other I do make and publish this on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of October in year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one signed and acknowledged in the presence of

15 In the name of God, Amen. I John Grant being of sound mind & memory, knowing the uncertainty of life & certainty of death do Publish and declare the following my last will and Testament

1<sup>st</sup> First, it is my will that my body shall be decently buried and all my just debts paid by my executor herein appointed

2<sup>d</sup> I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Anna the tract of land I now live upon with its bounds containing lands of James James and D. S. Alverly and Amel and Insurance during her natural life - and also I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Anna all my Horses, cattle, Hogs, Sheep, Hogsheads, Corn, Wheat, and all my personal property House hold & kitchen furniture both real & mixed and also and Cash on hand and my property whatever, to her my said wife, and after her death to be equally divided amongst my children

3<sup>d</sup> I hereby appoint my beloved wife Anna Grant the executrix of this my last will and Testament revoking all other wills heretofore made.
