disposing memory but feeble in body being desirous
to make some disposition of the worldly substance
with which God has blessed me do make ordain
and publish this my last will and Testament
in manner and form following.1st I will and bequeath unto my son Robert
A. Post and daughter Harriet C. Post all my
real and personal estate of every kind whatsoever
consisting of the houses and lots on which I
live the lots on which my stables are situated
joining the land formerly owned by W. S. Rainsome
and also another lot joining John Wilfong's stable
lot and also my plantation on the Smyth
Mill creek containing about one hundred acres,
household and kitchen furniture rail road stock
of ten shares in W. N. C. R. R. Co. and fourteen
shares in the Catawba Bridge Co. two mules anda number of cattle and Hogs notes and Book
accounts and all my other property of every
kind whatsoeverII I will and bequeath unto my daughter
Catharine Campbell six hundred dollars which
shall be paid her by my daughter Harriet and
son Robert.III I will and bequeath unto my son Adolphus
Post children six hundred dollars which shall
be paid to them by my son Robert and daughter
Harriet.IV I will that the above pecuniary legacies be a
charge upon the property given to my son Robert
and daughter Harriet till the same are paidV I will that my son Robert and Harriet pay
all my just debts out of the property left them and
apportion my grave proper tombstones pay all funeral
expensesV My other children I have already advanced to them
all that I am able to give them
