Last Will of Joseph Gillian Dec'd.
In the name of God, Amen.

Joseph Gillian of the County of Catawba
and State of North Carolina, being of sound
mind & memory but considering the uncertain-
ty of my earthly existence do make & declare
this my last Will & testament, In manner
and form following: That is to say:

1st. That my executor herein after named
shall provide for my body a decent burial
suitable to the request & wishes of my
friends & relations & pay all my funeral
expenses together with my just debts
whosoever & to whomsoever owing out of
the moneys that may first come to
hand as at parcel or part of my estate
Item, I will & devise to my beloved wife
Ragena, She shall have as much of the
household & kitchen furniture as will
render her comfortable during her natural
life & further that she shall have one cow
& one heifer & four head of hogs & three
head of sheep & ten bushels of wheat and
fifty Bushels of corn.

Item. I will & devise to my daughter
Mahala one cow & calf & the increased
two Bedsteads & furniture for the same &
kitchen furniture as much as the rest
of my daughters got. I further direct that
said Mahala be permitted to live on
the home plantation while she remains
single.

3 Item. I will & direct that my youngest
son Casper C. Gillian shall have part of
the home plantation & said Casper Gillian
to have the upper end of the plantation
the line running in the following form
beginning between me & Wm. Ginn's
place running with the Aaron Branch
to the mouth of the branch thence down
the creek to the hollow opposite the
