

Last Will and Testament of Laban S. Whiteman

North Carolina
Catawba County

I, Laban S. Whiteman of the aforesaid County and State
being of sound mind and in good health but Considering
the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make
and declare this my last will and testament.

(First) My executors hereinafter named shall give my body
a decent burial, and pay all funeral expenses
together with all my just debts out of the first
Money which may come into their hands belonging
to my estate.

(Second) I give and bequeath to my dear wife Amanda L. C.
all of the real estate and personal property together
with all money on hand or due me at the time of
my death, but I do advise her that it is my wish
that she do not sell the home place.

(Third) I give and bequeath to my Son John Sumner
Two hundred dollars worth of property to be divided
or apportioned to him after my wifes death.

(Fourth) I give and bequeath to each of my Sons Myron
Edward, Julius Wilford, and Horace Eugene three
hundred dollars in money or property to be divi-
ded and apportioned to them after the death of
my wife.

(Fifth) To each of my daughters Florence Etoile, Marie
Amelie, and Philibet Isabella, I give and bequeath
a one acre lot on the home place located as I
have explained to my wife to be given them when
they marry or after the death of my wife, on
this condition that neither they, their heirs nor
assigns, will at any time sell or allow to be
sold, spirituous or alcoholic liquor of any kind
and should either one do so, She shall forfeit all
right and title to the lot which shall revert to my
estate and be divided between my other heirs.

(Sixth) My will and desire is that after the death of my
wife all the remainder of my estate after paying
the before mentioned expenses and legacies shall
be equally divided between all my children.

(Seventh) I do appoint my dear wife Amanda L. C. to be the
executrix of the my last Will and Testament and do
appoint my Sons Amelie A and John Sumner to
act with her during her life time, and to execute
the provisions of the my will after her death.
