and disposing memory in view of the certainty of death
to all mankind do hereby make certain and declare
this to be my last Will and Testament.

1st I will and ordain that at my death my mortal remains be decently buried and my grave be marked with a plain but decent head stone the expenses of which to be paid out of my estate
2nd I will and wish all my just debts paid out of my estate.

3d I give and bequeath all the remainder of my Estate to be equally divided between my three nephews and one niece namely T. Lee Howe, Otis L. Howe & Willie Ellen Howe children of the late Thomas L. Howe and his wife D. Annie Howe and Willie Alexander son of Quincy A. Alexander

4th I hereby nominate constitute and
appoint my friend and nephew Quincy A.
Alexander my lawful Executor and my
niece D. Annie Lowe my lawful executrix to close
up this my last Will and Testament. hereby
revoking and disallowing all other former wills
by me made.

I hereby publish and declare the foregoing
to be my last Will and Testament this 12th day
of April in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and seventy.
