to all mankind do hereby make ordain and declare
this to be my last Will and Testament.

2nd I will and wish all my just debts
paid out of my estate.

3rd I give and bequeath all the remainder of my

L. Lowe and his wife D. Annie Lowe and Willie
Alexander son of Quincy A. Alexander

up this my last Will and Testament. Herby
