Snyder or any other ^{reputable} person in the same manner as if I were living, for such length of time as they may find it to be profitable to my estate and they can agree with my said partner or with such other discreet and safe person - and to enable them to do so I authorize them to use either of my store houses and such money and effects of my estate as they may need for that purpose.

IV I will and bequeath that if my beloved wife should marry ^{then} my property shall be divided between her, and my children according to the statute of distribution and, as in case of intestacy of myself.

V I will and appoint my friend C. A. Harick guardian of my sons Charlie and Harry.

VI I will and appoint my beloved wife Amanda guardian of my daughters Lucy, Anna and Mary Ellen.

VII I hereby appoint my beloved wife Amanda and my trusty friend Eli A. Harick the executors and executor of this my last will and testament.
