170 Miles Deal of the County of Catawba and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say

First I give and devise to my beloved wife Rosannah Deal all my Real and personal estate hereafter and wheresoever it may be to have and to hold to her the said Rosannah Deal for and during the term of her natural life or widowhood then to be equally divided among my children and last I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friend Mrs. Schaffey my lawful executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will & testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same in witness whereof I the said Miles Deal do hereunto set my hand & seal this 6th day of April 1863
