I William J. Brondel of the County of Catawba & State of North Carolina being of sound mind & memory but Considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make & declare this my last will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say First that my executor herein after named shall provide for my body a decent burial such as the wishes of my friends relations may desire and pay all funeral expenses together with all my just debts however & to whomsoever owing out of the manies that may first come into his hands as a part of my estate

2^d I Give & Leave my beloved wife Elizabeth all my Estate Real & personal during the term of her natural life or widowhood and at her death or marriage then it is all to belong to my daughter Frances & Brandel nowise depending if my wife Elizabeth marries she is to have as much stock as she brings to her at our marriage & half the house hold & kitchen furniture & as long as she (Elizabeth) remains my widow she is to have full possession of all my estate as here but not to waste or destroy any part of it but in case she may need any thing to live upon then in that case she is at liberty to sell such things of my personal property that she may have to spend in order to support the family and in case my daughter Frances & Brandel dies before her mother then my wife Elizabeth is to do as she pleases with the whole of my estate.

And Lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my trusty friends David & Martin my lawful Executor to all intents & purposes to execute this my last will & testament according to the true intent & meaning of the same & every part & clause thereof, hereby revoking & declaring utterly void all other wills and testaments by me hitherto made

County of Catawba & State of North Carolina to will & agree with to my
wife Elizabeth, General Grant my plantations for her to have & hold
forever and known as the Brandywine tract lying on Wall Creek
beginning at Seal Elias Langley & Nedra Elizabeth Stearns Langley
named Sees & Miles Barbare containing two hundred & seven by
five acres more or less the brandywine said tract Elizabeth Langley
& James Sees containing eighty one acres more or less I further will
bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Barbre grant all my money moneys clothes
Sheep, hogs, stills, horses, horses & Males and all my property including
one Negro woman by name Lovina & her child James for her to have
and to hold as long as she lives or lives a widow and after her
marrying or dying said negro lands and all other property are
to go to my children for them to have & to hold for ever in estimation
whereof I bequeath set my hand & affix my seal this the 16th day
of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
& Sixty four
