certain publish And declare this to be my

one small trunk And all my present crop

To my Daughter in Law Mary Jane Bold my
part in the Kitchen furniture one Buggy
harness, one Coat, one Bed and two Sheds, one
yarn Bed, one Corncrib, one piece quilt and
linen one Saddle, one Clock.

To Barbara Ellen Seton one Calf one Featherbed
To Laura Martha Ann Bullock one Bedstead
one large trunk. The balance of my estate
is to be ^{divided} equally Among my Grand Children
James, George, Barbara Ellen, William Arthur
And Laura Martha Ann Bullock Share & Share alike

And lastly I make, Appoint And Appoin
Alexander A Keen to be Executor of this my last
will And Testament hereby revoking all former
wills by me made.
