In the name of God Amen
 I, Sallie M. Hermon, being of sound mind and memory but feeble in health and considering the uncertainty of life, do this 15th day of April 1875 make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say,
 First I give and bequeath to my brother in law J. P. Spencer & family a certain tract of land known as the Jacob Seton place about 120 acres. It is further my will that said Spencer is to have the present crop on said land and the grain I have on hand. It is further my will that he is to have 25 quints. his choice By paying out one hundred dollars to my sister Amy Hermon, Mahala Eckard, Caroline Wagner and Clarinda & Fanny Hermon are to have both but one share
 2nd It is my will that my sister Adeline C. Hermon is to have a certain tract of land known as lot No 2 of the Alexander Hermon tract.
 3rd It is my will that my Hermon Mahala Eckard Caroline Wagner & Clarinda & Fanny Hermon are to have a certain lot of land No 13 on the South side of Rail Road about three acres (said Fanny & Clarinda are to have only one share that is the two are only to share as one of sisters. It is further my will that my sister Anna C. Spencer is to have my bureau. It is further my will that my part of the stock of bees remain on the farm for the use of the family and also my sheep. It is further my will that all my property not otherwise will be sold after my death by my executor and the money equally divided between my sisters and Miles, their names Clarinda & Fanny.
 It is further my will that all my expenses be paid out of my money and notes and the balance if any be equally divided between my heirs as above.
