 but feeble in health and Considering the uncertainty
 of life, do this 15th day of April 1875 make and publish to this
 my last Will and Testament in manner and form
 following that is to say,
 First I give and bequeath to my brother in law J. P.
 Spencer & family a certain tract of land known as
 the Jacob Seton place about 120 acres it is further my
 will that said Spencer is to have the present crop
 and said land and the grain I have on hand
 it is further my will that he is to have 2500
 lbs choice by paying out one hundred dollars to
 my sister Anna Hermon, Rebekah Eckard, Caroline Wagner
 and Clorinda & Fanny Hermon are to have both
 only one share
 2d It is my will that my sister Adeline E. Hermon
 is to have a certain tract of land known as
 lot No 3 of the Alexander Hermon tract
 3d It is my will that my Hermon Rebekah Eckard Caroline
 Wagner & Clorinda & Fanny Hermon are to have a
 certain lot of land lot 13 on the south side of Rail
 road about three acres (said Fanny & Clorinda as to
 have only one share that is the two acre ~~only~~ to share
 as one of sisters It is further my will that
 my sister Diana E. Spencer is to have my beani it
 is further my will that my part of the stock of
 bees remain on the farm for the use of the
 family and also my sheep It is further my will
 that all my property not otherwise will be sold
 after my death by my executor and the money
 equally divided between my sisters and Mrs.
 Hermon namely Clorinda & Fanny
 It is further my will that all my expenses be paid
 out of my money and notes and the balance if any
 be equally divided between my heirs as above
 It is further will that J. P. Spencer be my executor and
 hereby nominate and appoint Executor of this my last Will and
