

April Session 1858

In the name of God Amen  
I Ambrose Miller of the County of Catawba and State of North Carolina being in bad health but of perfect sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first that my executors herein after named shall provide for my body a decent funeral suitable to the wishes of my friends and relations and pay all funeral expenses together with all my just debts out of the money that may just come to his hands as part of my estate.  
Item First I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Amanda the tract of land I now live on containing one hundred and fifty four acres together with all the buildings and improvements appertaining thereto also first choice of my stock of horses also first choice of my stock of cattle that is here brute and one cow brute also all my flock of sheep also six hogs choice of the stock also all my house and kitchen furniture to have and to hold the said property during her natural life or widowhood but in case she should marry again this devise is to be null and void and of no effect from the time she marries.

Item I also will and bequeath to my five sons that is to say William J. Thomas A. C. Anderson M. Emmanuel W. Ambrose J. all the residue of my land not disposed of to be equally divided among my five sons to have and to hold the same as their absolute proportion.

Item I also will and bequeath to my daughter Harriet H. one dollar in money I also will and bequeath to my daughter Catharine M. one bed a spinning wheel one cow a pair of cards a set of knives and forks a set of cups and saucers also a wash pot and a wash tub also a cooking pot it is further my will that my executors sell all my personal property to public sale and if there should be any surplus of money left after paying all just debts and demands it is my will that the same be equally divided among my said wife Amanda and my five sons and my daughter Catharine M.

It is further my will that in addition to what I have divided to my said wife that she shall receive for a years allowance twenty eight bushels of wheat and fifty bushels of corn and that I would advise and feel gratified to her to remain unmarried and lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my beloved brother Abel Miller and Paul Miller my carefull executors to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same. In witness whereof the said Ambrose Miller has caused to set my hand and seal this the 9 day of September 1858

The last will and testament of Sarah Sherrill of the County of Catawba and State of North Carolina I Sarah Sherrill considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound mind and memory so make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that I wish all my just debts to be paid I give and bequeath unto my son Silas W. Sherrill one negro boy named bid the said Silas W. to pay one note that I owe to Elizur Sherrill of two hundred and fifty seven dollars and the interest of the same I also give my red rooster to my two sons John & Silas W. I also give my son Silas W. my claybank fully named pigeon also one cow and a calf one bull and a heifer also one hen and bed cloths I also give my farming tools to my two sons John & Silas W. to have equal parts in them I also give my hog to my son Silas W. also I give my flock to him I also give my three daughters Leudina Mahala and Little Eppie Sherrill my cubra household and kitchen furniture I also give my sheep to my six sons Elizur J. Nicklas Elisha F. James W. John & Silas W. Sherrill also give the growing crop to my two sons John & Silas W. and three daughters Leudina Mahala Little Eppie Sherrill my son Silas W. Sherrill to pay Leudina Sherrill fifty dollars I also give to my son John & Silas W. one black horse named cock and one small filly named bit also one cow and calf one hen and bed clothing I also give to my other daughter one cow and a calf back Leudina Leudina has her hens to wheat meat and corn on hand at this time I give to my two sons John & Silas W. and three daughters Leudina Mahala and Little Eppie Sherrill also give my four sons Elizur J. Nicklas Elisha F. and Silas W. Sherrill one claybank fully named Zop I also give my daughter Little Eppie one side saddle to be paid for out of the growing crop the remainder of the growing crop I give to my two sons John & Silas W. and three daughters Leudina Mahala Little Eppie Sherrill It is my will that Leudina and Silas W. Sherrill do take charge of the old negro woman Nancy and take good care of her I hereby appoint my son Elizur J. Sherrill Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made in this place of I have also set my hand and seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and eight hundred and fifty eight  
The above instrument consisting of one sheet was now here subscribed by Sarah Sherrill the testator in the presence of each of us and was at the same time delivered by her to be her last will and testament to be at her request sign our names her to as attesting witness
