I, Susan Stiles of the County of Catawba and State of North Carolina being weak in body and sound mind and memory praise be God for the same do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following:

I give devise and bequeath unto Eva Blalock a daughter of Lizzie Blalock her heirs and assigns forever the following property two head of cattle 1 Hog two Bststeads three feather Beds Eight Blankets two coverlids Seven counterpanes One clock Six chairs All my Delft and table ware two tables One chest one trunk One pair dog irons one cupboard one wheel & pair cards three under Bed ticks all my clothing and dress patterns & cloth of every kind two ovens & lids One wash pot One dinner pot two pans & lids. Also all my other property real personal and mixed of what nature or kind soever and wheresoever the same shall be at the time of my death. I do nominate constitute and appoint A. D. Shuford my Sole Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void any and all other will or wills by me made and do declare this to be my last will and testament. In witness whereof I, the said Susan Stiles have hereunto set my hand this 27th day of Nov. 1890
