

# Will of William Bandy

In the name of God, Amen.

I, William Bandy being of sound mind and memory  
do make declare and publish this as my last Will and  
Testament.

Item First - I want my executor to furnish for me a  
decent burial and funeral expenses and collect all  
just debts coming to me and to pay all my just debts.  
My will is for my son Theodore Lefayatt Bandy and  
his heirs to have one dollar of my estate also my will  
is for Adolphus Davenport Bandy and his heirs to  
have one dollar of my estate also I want Perry Franklin  
Bandy's heirs two children Effie and Avery to have  
five dollars to each of them. Also my will is for my daughter  
<sup>Bandy her heirs</sup> Catherint ains to have one dollar of my estate  
Also my will is for Nancy Marey Elin <sup>redundant</sup> and her heirs to  
have one dollar of my estate the balance of my estate it  
is my will that Joseph Scofield Bandy and Burley Mitchell  
Fin Canon is to have the balance of my estate as I desire  
it I will Burley Fin Canon twenty five acres of land, described  
as follows Commence at mine and T.S. Bandys red oak  
corner near a branch known as the Cain corner then runne  
nearly South <sup>land at Brumwold</sup> <sup>Bandy</sup> what (my granddaughter younger daughter)  
is to hav my interest in the store house lot at the cross roads after  
my death) the Nancy gate and corners on 2 small <sup>acres</sup> <sup>acres</sup>  
East of said gait then from said hickreys merley East  
crossing the Creek <sup>mine</sup> and Martin Sigmans line on they  
road on the other side joining T.L. Bandys line and mine it  
shal be twenty five acres in the track the Balance of my land  
I will to my son Joseph Bandy

Burley Fin canon is to hav what bedding <sup>taker</sup> my wife give to her  
also her wairing close also she shall have one good bed  
and stid of nine also she shall have one table and a good  
table outfit of dishes good set of knives and forks and a set  
of good chirs She shall have one Center Table if she marries or  
leaves me befor my deth this shall be void but the  
land shall stand The other property I will provide for  
her But my son Joseph is to have all my loss property  
as he has done moar for me than the rest of my children

Lastly I nominate and appointe my son  
Joseph Scofield Bandy the executor of this  
my last will and testament hereby  
revotting all former wills
