In the name of God, Amen. I W. L. McHaffey being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of life do this day make & publish this my last will and Testament in manner & form following to wit:

Item first I give and bequeath unto my wife ^{Francesina} Mahala McHaffey all my estate real and personal with the exception of horse stock of which she is to have two head her choice, the remainder if any over hand are to be sold, said property I will to her during her natural life time, and after her death it is my will that all my property not otherwise willed be sold by my Executor hereafter named and equally divided between all my lawful heirs.

2^d I give to my son Joseph L. McHaffey a sorrel saddle bridle, It is further my will that my son Joseph G. is to have my plantation I now live out after the death of my wife by paying each of his sisters the sum of Two hundred dollars.

3^d It is further my will that all my daughters be made equal with my oldest daughter A. C. McHaffey.

Item 4th I nominate ordain and appoint my son Joseph G. McHaffey and C. W. Hermon Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
