

Will of William Rufus Cobb

North Carolina - Last will and testament
of William Rufus Cobb

I William Rufus Cobb of the aforesaid county and
State being of sound mind but considering
the uncertainty of my earthly existence do
make and declare this my last will and
testament.

First: My executrix hereinbefore named shall give
and pay to my dear wife Julia and pay all my
just debts out of the first moneys (wherefrom)
come into her hands hereafter to my wife

Second: I give and devise to my beloved children
- Elizabeth Letitia, Maria Jackson, John William
Thomas E. Lewis Eugene, David, John, Jr.
and John Mabel, five dollars each.

Third: I give and devise to my two little grand-
children John and Emily Letitia five and six
dollars each and to my little grand-
daughter Letitia Letitia five dollars.

Fourth: I give and devise to my son William
James Cobb all the residue of my property
and all the above items are executed first
which he will remain at home and
properly care and provide for myself and
his mother during our lifetime and
until we both shall die, that he
shall perform his duty then in that
case all said property to be kept and per-
manently (that is to say) in form to which ever
I shall will delegate myself or myself or ex-
ecutors and care for us during our natural
lives.

Fifth: I hereby constitute and appoint my blood
relative my executrix to all debts and pay-
ments to execute this my last will and
testament according to the true meaning
thereof. I also hereby revoke and declare
utterly void all other wills and testaments
by me heretofore made.

February 1st 1891. (Seal)
