my beloved wife Betsey Burnett a negro slave named
Sara during her natural life time as I have her by and
in case of her marriage the negro man shall then to be
returned and hired out until my youngest Boy shall
come of age and then the principal and interest of
the hire of said negro Sara to be equally divided amongst
my Boy children. I give unto my beloved wife a good
Bed Furniture. I also give my beloved wife a superb
dilly a year old last Spring called Filly who in equal
share of my Household Furniture with my children

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My Will further is if the insufficiency of my Stock to pay all
my Just debts the payment being between three and four
hundred dollars. My Will further is that a Negro woman
named Pegg and a Negro but child named Bessy be
sold if any surplus should remain of said Negroes
and Stock to be equally divided amongst all my
Children. My Will further is that my first Children
shall have a good Bed Furniture raised out of my
estate and one Cow & Calf for each of them. My
Will further is that my sons after getting common
schooling, that should be born a out, two and two to-
gether to the trade of Horse carpentering. I also give
unto my beloved sons (Three Tracts of Land in the
State of Minnesota, one for the Shawana & series of
Land lying between the Rainy Fork & Humboldt
River granted Isaac Laurence. Also another
tract of Land containing 140 Acres lying on Spoon
Creek granted Robert Miller. Also another tract
of Land lying on Maudsloo Creek granted
Major Robert Miller. Also my part of Land
that Anna Cox holds my Son & for to be equal-
ly divided amongst all my Children. I also
constitute my beloved Brother Isaac Burnette
my lawful executor. it being my last Will and
Testament, the 31st day July 1804
