one Loom and bed and furniture and one Cow one Chest and table
two pewter dishes two pewter plates one Dozen delf Plates half
a dozen Spoons one Coffee pot the black bottles one silver more
Coff two year old pot one Kettle and Oven there to be Possessed
by her for ever. Also I give unto my son John all the Land
that I Possess in this County for him and his heirs forever
to possess for ever and I further give unto my son John one
Silver ^{done} Cuff near one year old. I Also gave unto my son Samuel the
sum of five Pounds to be raised out of my Estate
I Also gave unto my Daughter Elizabeth the sum of two
pounds ten shillings to be raised out of my Estate I Also
gave unto my Daughter Mary the sum of two pounds
ten shilling to be raised out of my Estate

gave unto my Daughter Rebecca one bed and furniture one
bedstead one cow and calf one Walnut Chest one Spinning wheel
one saddle and bridle and fifty five dollars half a dozen of
pewter plates half dozen of tea ware one big bale two paster-dishes
two paster-basons half dozen spoons one datchet oven and pot
I Also gave unto my daughter Susanna one feather bed and furniture
Bedsteads one cow and calf one Walnut chest one Spinning wheel
one saddle and bridle and ninety five dollars one datchet oven
and pot and dresser furniture Equal with Rebecca

I Also gave unto my daughter Sarah one feather bed and bedstead
and furniture one cow and calf one case of drawers one Spinning
wheel one saddle and bridle and ninety five dollars one datchet
oven and pot and dresser furniture Equal with Rebecca

I Also gave unto my Daughter Rhoda one feather bed and
bedstead and furniture one cow and calf one case of drawers
one Spinning wheel one saddle and bridle and ninety five dollars
one datchet oven and pot and dresser furniture Equal with Rebecca

The Remainder part of my Property to be Equally divided
Among my children and wife namely My wife Anna Saml
Elizabeth Mary Rachel Rebecca John Susanna Sarah
Rhoda Anna —

I Also Appoint Samuel Culverson and William Jones
to constitute and make and obtain The sole Executors

I this my Last Will and Testament and Odo here by utterly disallow
Revoke and Demand all and Every other former testaments
wills legacies bequests Executors by me in Any way before named
Willed and Bequeathed Nullifying and Confirming this and no
other to be my Last Will and Testament in witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 10th day of February
in the year of our Lord one Eight hundred and two

delivered by the said Andrew Culberson as
his last Will and Testament in the presence
