which was of my ~~children~~ children he might have

Horse to him and his heirs forever. I give to my daughter
Lucy Abbott my side Saddle to her and her heirs forever.
I give to my daughter Mary Lloyd one Calico Hat
to her and her heirs forever. I give to my daughter
Abigail Brown one Calico Hat and one blue Ribbon
Dress to her and her heirs forever. All the remainder
of my estate except my wearing apparel. I leave to be
equally divided amongst the whole of my children
except Anne Justice. I leave all my wearing apparel
to be equally divided between my four daughters
Mary Lloyd Elizabeth Abbott, Lucy Abbott and
Sally West to be theirs & their heirs forever. Lastly I
constitute and appoint my son Philmore Lacy and

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my son in law Stephen Carter Executor of this my last
Will and Testament. In witness whereof, I do hereunto set
my hand and seal this 30th day of May 1811. He was

Lara and the name Elizabeth Aesch interlined before
