of Chatham and State of North Carolina being perfect in health
and sound in mind and memory and knowing It is allotted for
all men Once to die, I do hereby make and appoint this my last
will and Testament Arranging my affairs and disposing of my
worldly goods Goods as follows, I will give and bequeath my soul
to God who gave It and my body to the Earth to be decently
buried at the discretion of my Executors. and after the Payment
of my Just debts - I do hereby give and bequeath unto
Sally Betty (a) daughter of Henry Duggill all and singular
my worldly Goods that I now possess or may acquire and possess
hereafter consisting of the Plantation whereon I now live
be the Quantity of acres of Land more or less with my Iron
and tools and all my Stock of Cattle hogs Whips and dogs
with my bed Chamber Chests and Tables and all my house hold
and Kitchen furniture to have and to hold the above mentioned
property and hers for ever and I do hereby nominate
and appoint Stephen Walden my trusty friend as my lawful
Executor to Execute and fulfill this my last will and
Testament disannulling and Repealing all wills heretofore by
me made and acknowledged in this my last will
and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal. This in the year of our Lord
Christ One thousand Eight hundred and thirty six
and on the 15th day of June

The foregoing last will and Testament of Anthony
Evans deceased was duly exhibited in open Court at
August Term 1838 and proved by the oath of Archdald
Brown a witness thereto. Whereupon Administration with
