forever.

I then I give and bequeath to Brother Amos Simon
all the rest of my property (not heretofore given
away to him and his heirs forever

I then and lastly I do hereby constitute
constitute and appoint my trusty friend George
Johnson my Executor to this my last will
overriding all other by me made and acknowledge
this and this only to be my last will & testament
in manner and form as above stated
