lands also that my Executor out of my estate builds or
cause to be built a house upon the said land for the use
of my wife the house to be buildt large fourteen foot by eighteen
feet off and made comfortable for her to live in Also I
give her my bay mare the land and the Mare for her to
have and to hold during her life or while she remain my
widow also I give to my wife one Cow and Calf first chosen
of my stock two sheep and ten head of hogs and eighteen
Goats one plow and a pair of plow Geers and my Household
and Kitchen furniture except one bed and furniture there
things to be her service Thirdly I give to Nancy Jordan one
Cow and Calf and two Sheep fourthly I will that my
plantation wherein I now lie be sold after the settlement of
my estate and the money equally divided amongst my brother
and sister except brother Andrew and Sister Betty their two
parts to be equally divided amongst their children fifthly
I will that this may stand in full force and virtue after
my decease except my wife being great with Child at this
time should be luckily to bring a son to my body and if she
should I will that it should then the part of my estate
that I have herein written to my Brother and Sister and
their children Sixthly and lastly I appoint Attorney
Holloman and William Mathews to execute this my

last will and testament in witness whereof I set my 39
hand and seal the day and year above written -

I also give unto him one Negro man slave by the name of
Jordan and all other pieces of property that I have heretofore
put in his possession Then to my son John Harris I give
and bequeath in fee for ever the land wherein he now lives
in the said County Chatham I also give unto him a Negro man
slave by the name of Wilson together with all the other
pieces of property that I have heretofore put into his possession
Then to my Daughter Elizabeth Headen for ever I give her

the other pieces of property that I have heretofore put in
her and her Husband Aaron Headen's possession. — Item. To
my Son Harry Harris I give and bequeath in fee for ever the
tract of land wheron he has lived in the said County of
Chatham I also give unto him a negro man slave by the
name of Steridge together with all the other pieces of property
that I have heretofore put into his possession — Item. To my
Son Benjamin Harris I give and bequeath in fee for ever the
tract of land wheron he now lives in the said County of
Chatham. I also give unto him one negro man slave by the
name of Littleton together with all the other pieces of property
that I have heretofore put into his possession — Item. To my
Daughter Sally March forever I give three Negroes and their
increase, Lewis, Sally, Anna & Ben together with all other pieces
of property that I have heretofore put in her or her Husband
John March's possession. — Item. To my Daughter Dolly Mackay
— and I give for ever and their increase the following Negroes,
Court, Palma, Jerry, Sam, Pease Anna & Simon together
with all other property that I have heretofore put in her or
her Husband's possession. — Item. To my Son Britain Harris
I give and bequeath in fee for ever the tract of land wheron
he now he now lives in the said County of Chatham. I also
give unto him one negro man slave by the name of Simon
together with all the other property heretofore put into his possession
Item. To my Son Abraam I give and bequeath in fee for ever
the tract of land wheron he now lives in the said County
of Chatham. I also give unto him one negro man slave named
Simon together with all the other property that I have heretofore
put into his possession. — Item. To my Daughter Mary Harris
I give to her the following Negroes for ever and their increase
Dowtch, Humpy, Tanny, Eliza & Henry. I also give unto her two
Cows and Cales, two feather Beds, and furniture and one Horse
or Mau to be considered to be worth Seventy five Dollars

I am. It is my desire that after my Death and all
Ditti be paid that the Money arising from the sales of
perishable and personal property, that I might have left
behind be equally divided among ten of my Children
namely (twit, Fred Harris, West Harris, John Harris, Henry
Harris, Benjamin Harris, Britain Harris, Abraam Harris
Sally Marsh, Dolly - W. Daniel & Mary Harris. Item. It is
also my will and desire that the land wherein I now live
be sold after my death on a Credit of twelve Months and
that the Money that it may sell for when collected be equally
divided among them of my Daughters namely (twit, Sally
Marsh, Dolly - W. Daniel & Mary Harris - I also do hereby
reinstate and Appoint my three Sons (twit, West Harris
John Harris & Henry Harris Executors to this my last Will
and Testament - In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and Seal this 14th to the fourteenth day of May
