girl Lavina now in the possession of my Son in Law Mr. Jonathan  
Withers of Orange County be returned to my estate then after the pay-  
ment of all my Just debts I wish the residue of My Negroes to be equally  
divided amongst all my children & share alike lastly I  
Nominate and appoint my friends George W. Goldson and William  
S. Craig my whole and sole executors to this my last Will and testament  
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal  
this 24th day of Jan. A.D. 1829

I have then make an equal division with the girls that is to say one child part with the six last named to have full possession of the house and plantation where I now live until the two last named Boys are 21 years of age with all the stock and tools thereon to the use of her and family provided that she remains my Widow 2<sup>nd</sup> I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Edith Hockolt five dollars. 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath to my son unto my daughter Achia Hill five dollars 4<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my son Eli Vestal the plantation in Randolph adjoining John Scotten and others 5<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my son Sabin Vestal one half of the land in value where I now live and one house worth 60 or 70 dollars to be out of the stock now on hand 6<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Elwood Vestal the other half of the plantation where I now live on and one house worth 60 or 70 dollars out of the stock on hand to take possession at the age of 21 of the land and farming utensils to their use but not to dispossess their mother of her living while she remains my Widow and children get under age of the said plantation until they become of age. 7<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sally Vestal \$50 to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 8<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my daughter Puda Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 9<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ann Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 10<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ruth Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 11<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my daughter Emma Piscilla Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 12<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rhoda Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 13<sup>th</sup> the last named girls to draw their portion as they come to age of eighteen out of the stock first given to their Mother. it is also my Will that the remainder of my estate be left at the discretion of my wife. 14<sup>th</sup> it is also my Will if one of the last named boys Sabin and Benjamin Elwood die the other one heir his part and I hereby make and ordain my worthy Brother David Vestal and Eli Vestal executors of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said

Benjamin Vestal have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written.

First I give and bequeath unto my wife Sophia all the perishable property at her disposal which is not hereafter excepted. her in possession of the plantation where I now live as long as she remains my Widow or until it is named who is to take the charge thereof. Also 100 dollars in cash for the support of her and family. 2<sup>nd</sup> I give and bequeath unto my daughter Susan Smith ten dollars. 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath unto my two Sons Andrew and Price Vestal the Mill and land adjoining of said Mill belonging to me to say each one to have one half provided they pay to Caloun Six hundred dollars 500 each to pay him at the age of 21. 4<sup>th</sup> Sally and Conster Vestal to be made equal with Susan out of my stock now on hand it is also my Will that after all my debt debts is paid and the girls made equal the remainder be equally divided between all my heirs. 5<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath unto my son Calvin Vestal the tract of land I bought of Benson Pearce and forty four
