at the time of his death which is one third part of
said property to be his and at his disposal also
absolutely forever

Item I especially in addition to the above give
& bequeath to the said Simon F. Webster my bed and
furniture to be his absolutely forever

Item I also give and bequeath to Elizabeth Johnson
daughter of Harris Johnson my spinning wheel to
be hers absolutely forever And lastly I do hereby
constitute & appoint my truly friend Simon F. Webster
my lawful Executor to all intents & purposes to execute
my last will & testament according to the true
intent & meaning of the same & every part & clause
thereof hereby revoking & declaring utterly void all other
wills by me made In witness whereof I the said Cath
arine Foorster do hereby set my hand & seal this 27th Oct
