Chapman Two Negroes more by the name of Willy and
Hicks, one good Bed and Furniture. One Horse Brule
and Saddle. Two Cows & Calves, three sitting Chickens and
One Pot and Linnel, other articles, such as Nancy and
Charity had, so as to make Liddy equal with them
Item I give to Nancy and Charity my Two eldest daughters
Five Dollars a piece as I have given them their
portion off before. I give to my two sons Turner and
Solomon Chapman 280 Acres of Land to be equally
divided among them, and all the rest of my property for
which I may possess after the death of their Mother.
Item I do hereby make and appoint, Thomas Williams
& my son Turner Chapman my executors of this my
last will and Testament. In witness I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal the 11th Day of Jan^y. 1814 Signed Sealed & Delivered
