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 I then make an equal division with the girls that is to say one child part with the six last named to have full possession of the house and plantation where I now live until the two last named Boys are 21 years of age with all the stock and tools thereon to the use of her and family provided that she remains my Widow 2nd I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Edith Hockolt five dollars. 3rd I give and bequeath to my son unto my daughter Achsa Hill five dollars. 4th I give and bequeath to my son Eli Vestal the plantation in Randolph adjoining John Scotten and others 5th I give and bequeath unto my son Sabin Vestal one half of the land in value where I now live and one horse worth 60 or 70 dollars to be out of the stock now on hand 6th I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Elwood Vestal the other half of the plantation where I now live on and one horse worth 60 or 70 dollars out of the stock on hand to take possession at the age of 21 of the land and farming utensils to their use but not to deprive their mother of her living while she remains my Widow and children get under age of the said plantation untill they become of age. 7th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sally Vestal \$50 to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 8th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Poda Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 9th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Anna Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 10th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ruth Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 11th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Emma Priscilla Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 12th I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rhoda Vestal 50 dollars to say one bed and furniture and other necessary things to that amount. 13th the last named girls to draw their portion as they come to age of eighteen out of the stock first given to their Mother. it is also my Will that the remainder of my estate be left at the discretion of my wife. 14th it is also my Will if one of the last named boys Sabin and Benjamin Elwood die the other one their heir part and I hereby Make and ordain my worthy Brother David Vestal and Eli Vestal executors of this my last Will and testament in witness whereof I the said

Benjamin Vestal have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written.

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Acres, giving it on the south side. 6th I give and bequeath unto
my son William H Vestal the Remainder of My land, and farming
tools my Wagon and other tools thereon where I now live for him to
have possession at the age of 21 and to have the charge thereof and is
bound to maintain his Mother as long as she remain my Widow, for
to have precedence in the house with him it is also My Will that
My executor sell such things as he may think to be an advantage
to the estate and such as is not needed in the support of the
family and I hereby Make and ordain My Worthy
Executor of this my last will and testament in Witness whereof
