Ailey their future increase also the residue of my
property of every description not otherwise disposed
of - Item I give and devise to these Aaron Peoples
& John Hugh Peoples all my real Estate to have
and to hold to them the said John Aaron Peoples
& John Hugh Peoples their heirs and assigns
forever And lastly I do hereby constitute and

appoint my trusty friend Hugh Peoples my lawful
Executor to all intents and purposes, to execute this my
last will and Testament according to the true
intent and meaning of the same and every
part and clause thereof hereby revoking and
declaring null and void all other wills & Testaments
by me heretofore made In witness whereof
