of Chatham County and State of North Carolina; planter being
in full State of health and of perfect mind and memory
thanks be given unto God; calling unto mind the mortality of
my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
that is to say, principally and first of all, I give and
recommmend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that
gave it; and my body I recommend to the earth, to be buried
in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive
the same again, by the power of Almighty God. And as touch-
ing such worldly estate, wherewith it has pleased God to bless
in this life, I give, devise and dispose of the same in the
following manner and form.
First. I give and bequeath unto my four youngest daughters
namely Peggy, Nancy, Mary & Dorthy the sum of Fifty
Dollars each, to be raised and paid out of my estate.
Also I give to my two sons Donald McLean and
