Jennas unto the said Elijah Foorke his heirs and assigns
power and I the said Andrew Haynes do also warrant
her to be well, healthy, sound and clear from fits
any other jaundice, Complaints and with for ever defend
the said Slave with her Jennas from the claim or
demand of any person or persons whomsoever unto the
said Elijah Foorke his heirs and assigns. In
