out of her part Patsey Sedbetter have received property  
to the sum of forty dollars which must be taken out of  
her part Lucy M. Daniel have received property  
to the amount of fifty eight dollars which must be  
taken out of her part Charles S. Bright have received  
property to the amount of fifty five dollars which  
must be taken out of his part - Then over  
Susanna M. Daniel have received twenty dollars which  
must be taken out of her part after making the  
allowance named to share and share alike  
My will and desire is that my Executor pay over to  
each of my children and wife their respective shares  
after division takes place as before named except in  
the case of Susanna M. Daniel my will and desire in that  
case my Executor pay her part of the estate in several divis-  
ions to Henry Fields my beloved friend in trust for the  
use and benefit of his daughter's children to be  
paid over by said Henry Fields Trustee when the oldest  
becomes of lawful age or marries and he and with the  
rest of my will and hereby make it the duty of said  
Henry Fields Trustee to keep the money at interest  
until such time arrive that the children of my said  
daughter Susanna be entitled to receive the same
