Five Dollars in Cash to buy him a Desk. Item I give
unto my son Mordecai Barber as good a Home
Saddle and Bridle as Josiah and as much Stock of
every kind and as much household Furniture when he
marries or comes of age and all the remainder of my
estate after my Just debts are paid I leave unto my
beloved son Barber during her natural life in usufruct
except the exceptions should think the estate is wanting
but if she marry or at her death my executor will divide
my estate as underneath directed that is to say I give
unto son Mordecai Barber the Land and plantation
whereon I now live and my Desk, the balance of my
estate to be divided as follows my Negroes to be valued
I put in Lots and divided equally amongst all the
legates and the surplus and the surplus to be sold
Equally divided between my son Chaspin

Josiah Barber, Mordecai Barber, Rebecca Thompson
Nehemiah Midgett, Vincy Weatherspoon and Henry Howard
and I nominate and appoint my beloved son Josiah
Barber and John Chelley my full and sole Executors
of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand the day and date
above written.

I Elizabeth Jones of Chatham County Maiden
being weak in Body but of sound and disposing mind
memory and understanding do make this my last Will
and Testament as follows to wit First I will that my
Body be decently interred at the discretion of my Executors
hereafter named and as to all my worldly estate which
it shall please God to bestow upon me after payment
of all my Just debts I assign thereof as follows (that is
to say) I give and bequeath unto my Grand son John
Jones Brules my Malatto Girl Menah and my negroes
John and all my Land and that estate and all the
rest of my personal estate of what nature or kind soever
and whosoever situated. I give devise and bequeath unto
my son Thomas Jones of the western County and
Micajah Cohen of Chatham appointed Planter their

Their executors and administrators upon the be-
 come to and for the interest and purposes herein after
 mentioned expressed and declared of and concerning the same
 (that is to say) Upon trust to pay the said issues here and
 profits of the real and personal Estates to the proper hands
 of my daughter Mary Boulton the Wife of James Boulton
 to and for her own sole and separate use, for and during
 her natural life, and to be subject to the interment making
 of her present or any future husband nor in any manner
 subject or liable to him or any such future husband, debts,
 contracts or engagements, And her receipt signed with her
 proper hand, notwithstanding her present or any future
 Coverture to be a good and sufficient discharge or dis-
 charge for so much of the said Trust premises as shall
 be expressed therein to be received And given and after
 her decease, then On trust for and to the use of all
 and every of the Children of the said Mary Boulton
 equally to be divided between them if more than one shall
 share and share alike their Heirs Executors Administra-
 tors. And if there shall be but one such Child, then to
 the use of such one or only Child her or her Heirs Exec-
 utors and administrators. And in default of any issue of
 her to any living at my said daughter's death then on
 trust to and for the only use and benefit of my son
 (Thomas Boulton her Executor and Administrator and
 I do appoint my said son Thomas Boulton and the said
 Abigail Boulton Executors of this my last Will &
 and Testament. Hereby making all former and

other Will by me heretofore made, declaring this only to be
 my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I the
 said Elizabeth Jones the Testatrix have hereunto set my
 hand and seal this twenty fourth day of August in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 seven. (This my Will being written on two sheets of paper
 to the last I have set my hand and seal, and to the
 first my hand only. By me sealed, published, declared
 by the said Testatrix as and for her last Will and
 Testament. She was at the time and during her natural life
 near the middle of the first sheet, and she was any
 issue of her body living at my daughter's death
 in the last line of the said first sheet, being first
 interlined in the presence of us who at her request then
 subscribed our names as witnesses hereto. I the undersigned
 have being first struck I the words any issue of her body
 being first interlined thereof before the execution of this Will.
