Item 2. I gave to my son Allen Powell one gray Coll one Feather bed to him and his heirs forever -

Item 3. I gave to my son Stephen twenty one and one half acres of Land where he now lives one Feather Bed and better Cearing to him and his heirs ~~forever~~

Item 4. I gave to my son Richard one sorrel Coll and Feather bed one Cow and Calf -

Item 5. I gave to my son Farow Ten dollars one Feather Bed

Item 6. I gave to my son Eaton fifty acres of land known by name of Allen Powell Tract of Land. one Feather bed and better Cearing to him and his heirs ~~forever~~

Item 7. I gave to my son Will one third part of the Tract of Land that I bought of Humphry Wilson one Feather bed to him and his heirs and one better Cearing to him and his heirs -

Item 8. I gave to my son Eliza one third part of the Tract of Land that I bought of Humphry Wilson one Feather bed one better Cearing to him and his heirs.

Item 9. I gave to my son Murre one third part of the Lands that I bought of Humphry Wilson. one Feather bed one better Cearing to him and his heirs -

Item 10 - I gave to my Daughter Winne An five dollars

Item 11. I gave to my son Zachariah five dollars

Item 12. My wife being now pregnant not yet known
whether it will be a son or daughter I give it five
dollars. and after the death of wife or Marriage for
my lands where I live containing fifty eight acres
to be equally to be divided ^{between} Winnean and Zachariah
and the one my wife is now pregnant with -

My desire and wish is that my Crop or so of the same
to be sold as will be sufficient to pay all my debts
And I also appoint my son Allen Powell my executor
to this my last will and Testament
