Proved May Session 1824 —

I Eliza Ramsey of the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina
being of sound mind and memory do make publish and declare
the following to be my last Will and Testament:

I nominate and appoint Capt. John Bruce and Charles P. Jones of
the Town of Fayetteville my Executors — I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Maria Louisa Ramsey my watch chain and Purse and
two silver Tea Spoons

I give and bequeath to my son Albert Gallatin Ramsey his silver
Tea Spoon my silver Sugar Tong

I give and bequeath to my son John Calhoun Ramsey his
large silver Spoon. — My Will is that all my Bed & table Linen
Bedstead given to me by Capt. Bruce be equally divided amongst
my three Children above named — I give and bequeath to my

Daughter Maria Bruce my Bell metal Shells, and my sister Caroline
Jones my Brass Mirror & fiddle and my children, crib and the
Bed belonging to it — And my Will is that all the remainder
of my personal estate (except my Negroes sold by my Executors
and the proceeds together with such debts as are owing to me be
applied to the payment of my debts

My Will is that my Executors sell the plantation & land

whereon I now reside at such time and place and on such Credit terms and
Conditions as they may deem most Advantageous to my Estate and the same
applied to the payment of my debts and up the price and the Amount of
the sale of my personal Property, and the debts owing to me should not
be sufficient to pay my debts then I authorize my Executors to sell such
one of my Negro Children as they may think best to defray such balance
but if my debts should be paid from the Other funds and any balance left
my Will is that it be put out on Interest for the benefit of my Children
I give and bequeath my smallest Bedstead to Margaret M. Finck
I my other Beds, tables &c but not the Bed clothes, which was herein
already disposed of — My Will further is that my plantation
on Deep River known by the Name of the Stock place be conveyed by my
Executors, and when ever it can be sold for fair and reasonable price
I authorize my Executors or the survivor of them to sell it and to use
the proceeds in the stock of any Bank of this State or of the United
States, and the dividends thereof and the Interest of any other funds
belonging to my Estate be applied to the Maintenance and Edu-
cation of my Children — I authorize and direct my Executors
to hire my Negroes at public sale, or by private hiring or
Contract as they may deem most prudent
