my interest in the negroes willed to me by my Father
upon the death of my Mother and then I leave together
with the increase of any and all of the aforesaid negroes
for and during her natural life and at her death to
my next of kin.

Then I give and bequeath unto my wife Catharine
the following Negroes viz Niddy, Ekego, Landt
Emeline to have and to hold to be kept her heirs
Executors and administrators forever.

Then I give devise & bequeath unto my beloved
wife Catharine all my real Estate for and during
her natural life and at her death to my own
right heirs.

Then I give and bequeath unto my wife Catharine
all the rest and residue of my property or Estate
consisting of money notes accounts or otherwise
absolutely forever.

Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and
